Lead results only show recent exposure. If lead levels are low, please retest in 6 months.

## ELEVATED BLOOD LEAD LEVEL CASE MANAGEMENT

CHAP provides Elevated Blood Lead Level (EBLL) Nurse Case Management for children 17 and under who have a blood level greater than or equal to 5g/dL.

This service can also help your family apply for lead abatement services for your home if you have a child and meet state eligibility criteria.
